### Tips:

- b. Plants must be in a pot not over 20 cm and potted at least a month before Fair date.
- c. Please use clear glass or plastic containers of a size appropriate to size of flower(s) being displayed.
- d. Only one entry, per exhibitor, for each category.
- e. Not responsible for broken or lost containers.
- f. To keep stems straight for showing, roll their entire length in damp newspaper, place in warm water. Keeps them for days.

### Flowers

1. Aster, 3 sprays
2. Begonia, 1 bloom floating in a bowl, own foliage
3. Calendula, 3 blooms
4. Cleome (Spider Plant), 3 stems
5. Coneflower (Echinacea), any colour, 3 blooms
6. Cosmos, 5 stems
7. Gloriosa Daisy (Rudbeckia), 3 stems
8. Dahlia, 1 bloom and foliage, 15 cm or over
9. Dahlia, 1 bloom and foliage, under 15 cm
10. Flowering Shrub, 1 branch 76 cm maximum
11. Gaillardia, 3 blooms
12. Geranium, 1 stem with foliage
13. Gladiolus, miniature, any colour, 1 spike
14. Gladiolus, any colour, 1 spike
15. Gladiolus, variegated, 1 spike
16. Gladiolus, any variety, 3 spikes
17. Hosta, 3 leaves, same variety
18. Hosta, 3 leaves, different varieties
19. Hydrangea, 1 stem ball type
20. Hydrangea, 1 stem cone type
21. Larkspur, 3 stems, any colour
22. Lavatera, 3 stems
23. Marigold, 3 blooms, 7.5 cm or over, with own foliage
24. Marigold, 5 blooms, under 7.5 cm, with own foliage
25. Mums, 3 sprays
26. Nasturtium, 5 blooms with own foliage
27. Pansies and Violas, 5 stems with own foliage
28. Phlox, any variety, 3 stems
29. Petunia, double, 3 sprays
30. Petunia, single, 3 sprays
31. Salvia, 3 stems, any colour
32. Sedum, 3 stocks, named if possible
33. Snapdragon, any colour 3 spikes
34. Sunflower, 3 heads not more than 15 cm
35. Sweet Peas, any variety, 5 stems
36. Verbena, 3 stems
37. Zinnia, small, 3 stems
38. Zinnia, large, over 10 cm, 1 stem
39. Any other annual flower not listed above, named if possible, 3 blooms or stems or 1 large bloom
40. Any other perennial not listed above, named if

- possible, 3 blooms or stems or 1 large bloom
41. A container of Herbs, 3 to 5, named if possible
42. Any other cultivar of bulb, corm or rhizome, up to 5 stems
