5. All entries in the creative writing section must be completed and submitted by June 28, 2017 and all other entries may be taken to the arena between 7:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. on Monday, September 11, 2017 and Tuesday, September 12, 2017 before 11:00 a.m.
6. All entries must remain on display until 6:00 p.m. Wednesday, September 13, 2017. The arena will be locked for the night at 9:30 p.m. Entries may also be picked up between 9:30 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. on Thursday, September 14, 2017.
7. The Fair Board will not be responsible for any entries not picked up by 11:00 a.m. on Thursday, September 14, 2017.
8. All entries are at owner's risk but will be protected as far as possible by Fair Management.
9. The following information is to appear on the back of each entry: **pupil's name, grade, school and teacher's name.**
